

Zoom lesson guidelines

- Children need to arrive on time to the sessions. If you are over 5 minutes late then the lesson will start and we cannot guarantee you will be admitted. This is because the teacher has started teaching.
- Please ensure that children are sat in a central location (living, dining room) and preferably at a table. If children are sat in their bedroom at a desk then please make sure the door is open and a parent is nearby. We would not expect children to be led in bed or on the floor.
- Children need to have a pen/pencil and paper. There may be further items to bring which teachers will let children know beforehand.
- Please make sure the children are appropriately dressed e.g. no PJs.
- We know that there are lots of distractions at home but please encourage your children to actively take part in the lesson. If they can avoid showing pets etc that would be greatly appreciated.
- Teachers will be in contact with parents if we have any concerns with how children are conducting themselves on Zoom. E.g. we have had some children trying to draw on teacher's screen and pulling faces at each other.
- The background must be neutral and stay the same throughout the session.
